

### GUEST ARTIST: TIM RUSH

Tim Rush has been a performing percussionist, teacher, clinician, composer, and recording artist in Southeastern Wisconsin since 2001.

Originally from East Troy, WI, Mr. Rush started his musical journey as most young musicians do, by joining school band in 5th grade. "It was at that point that I knew what I wanted to do for the rest of my life," he often says. As a teenager, Rush furthered his musicianship by studying music privately, joining the Milwaukee Youth Symphony Orchestra, and performing professionally by the age of 14.

Primarily a drumset player, Rush has furthered his palate to include classical percussion, pitched mallet percussion, and instruments from cultures around the world.

In 2001, he started Caribbean Eclipse, a musical ensemble centered around the steelpan as a lead instrument. While Caribbean Eclipse can involve up to 8 musicians rocking the big stage, Rush most often performs as a duo with his long time friend and marimba player, John Seydewitz.

In 2007, Mr. Rush started an educational steel band program through the Milwaukee Youth Symphony Orchestra. This program can serve up to 36 students, geared toward City of Milwaukee residents and Milwaukee Public Schools.

Mr. Rush received his Bachelor of Music degree from Northern Illinois University, where he was introduced to the National Instrument of Trinidad and Tobago, the steelpan. He then received his Master of Music from Arizona State University, while directing the ASU Pan Devils Steel Band, studying, performing, and teaching in the Phoenix area. Since then, steelpan has been a primary focus of his teaching and performing career.

Rush has performed throughout most regions of the US, and has toured internationally, including Germany, Austria, Switzerland, France, Taiwan, and Jamaica. He currently resides in Lake Geneva, WI, and focuses on nurturing the culture of steelpan in the Midwest.
